

General Information (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY):

1. **Membership Passes are valid from October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2012.**
2. **The waiver on this form must be signed by all adult members listed on the form and by parents on behalf of skiers under 19 years of age.**
3. **Please wear your membership identification card at all times when skiing. Trails are patrolled.**
4. **Passes are non-transferable and non-refundable; except for refund policy.**

Dog Policy:

- A maximum of two dogs per skier on the following trails: Dog, Copper from Crossroads to Copper Haul Road, Lower & Upper Valley and connectors, Logan Burn, Chalet to Ketza and Ketza Connector, Mt McIntyre Ascent/Descent.
- Access from the Mt Mac Parking Area or Dog Trail Parking Area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Stadium.
- Dog owners are responsible for their dogs and assume the risk that other dogs will be encountered.
- Please keep dogs under control when approaching or overtaking other skiers and use a leash where requested.
- **Please remove dog feces from trail surface. At parking lots, stadium and trailheads, pick up and place waste in receptacles provided.**
- **Dog owners subject to City Bylaws.**

Refund Policy: Refund insurance is required for membership refund. Refunds will be issued by the WCCSC Executive on approved medical condition or employment transfer only if refund insurance has been purchased. Refund amounts are based on the following criteria:

Prior to October 31 - 95% Nov 1 to Nov 30 - 75% Dec 1 to Jan 31 - 50 % Feb 1 and later - 0%

- Carry cell phone – speed dial ski club phone number – 668-4477
- Emergency kits located at trail huts: Harvey, Fireweed, Sarah Steele – contain blankets, matches, firestarter, extra toques, mitts.
- AED (automatic emergency defibrillator) located in Wax Room – north wall
- Ski Club Emergency plan is located under Wax of the Day board
- Hypothermia kit available at ski club office
- Pay phone located 30 m south of Wax Room entrance (at curling rink entrance)
- Prepare yourself – a minor injury can lead to hypothermia
- Let somebody know your route – or use the sign out book at entrance
