  - Have a good level of skiing in classic technique and/or skate skiing
  - Organized, reliable and enthusiastic
- **Required Certification or Documents**
  - Criminal records check (WCCSC will provide a request letter to give the RCMP office)
  - Ski instruction/coaching certifications, though if you don't have any, CANSI Level 1 is offered November 11-13, 2021 in Whitehorse and the club is covering fees if you commit to 2 year of instructing.
